#### EBENEZER SCRIP PROGRAM INFORMATION 2023-2024 School Year

The SCRIP program is a great opportunity to reduce tuition costs through your everyday shopping. SCRIP is a certificate or gift card issued in place of money. We get cash back from our purchase of SCRIP. It works this way:

- You pay the face value (full value) when you purchase a Lynden Chamber of Commerce Community Cash (Lynden Dollars) Check/Certificate, or a gift card through Ebenezer's SCRIP program.
- When you use the Certificate or gift card, the business only gets either 90% or 96% of the face value.
- The remaining percentage, or rebate, is retained by Ebenezer. It is placed in an account that is able to apply a credit to your future tuition.
- The current SCRIP Coordinator is Swandel Ekema.

**There is a twice-yearly pay-out.** In May and November, we run a report of all your purchases of checks and gift cards, and how much rebate money resulted from your purchases. That amount will be applied to the next tuition statement.

### How to Participate

- If you do not have a student at Ebenezer, and are planning to **enroll in the future**, you need to contact the SCRIP coordinator to set up your "Future Eagles" account. The rebates accumulated by "Future Eagles" will be paid out on the November tuition statement in the child's first year at ECS.
  - If you start a "Future Eagles" account and later are not able to enroll your children due to
    personal choice or class size, the remaining funds in your family account may be designated by
    you to another family, or as a general donation to the board.
- If you are enrolled at Ebenezer, you may create a SCRIP account by contacting the SCRIP coordinator at <u>SCRIP@ebenezerchristianschool.org</u>.
- RAISE RIGHT (Formerly known as ONLINE SCRIP) is now overseen by the SCRIP coordinator, please email <u>SCRIP@ebenezerchristianschool.org</u> to sign up or to ask questions.

**Orders:** When placing an order, **please fill out the form in its entirety.** A photocopy of the form will be made and sent back to you with your order. **Make sure your name and phone number are on the forms.** 

**Family Tuition Account:** Please put the names of the parents in this spot (Smith or John Smith if more than one family in the school with the same last name). This is important especially for your friends or relatives who are placing orders to benefit your account; it helps us make sure the credit goes to the right family.

**Your payment must accompany the order form**. Place them in the SCRIP folder in the school office **by noon on Wednesdays**. Orders will be ready for pick up by noon on Thursday, unless specific vendor checks need to be ordered. You can expect to receive the vendor check portion of your order on the following Thursday.

**PLEASE MAKE CHECKS PAYABLE TO ECS SCRIP**. If the unforeseen happens, and a check bounces, you will be responsible for any related bank fees.

VENMO is now an approved payment option. You must pay via Venmo BEFORE you turn in your order form. The Venmo account is @<u>Ebenezer-SCRIP.</u> If you indicate Venmo on the order form, and the money has not been transferred, the SCRIP Coordinator will attempt to contact you via the information on the order form. Your order will be held until payment has been made. (Make sure you put your phone number on the form)

**Disclaimers:** Anyone sending orders home with a student must have a current **SCRIP Disclaimer on file**. A new disclaimer must be signed each academic year. No disclaimer on file? Then you must pick up orders from the office.

Additional order forms and disclaimer forms are located in the hallway right outside the school office, and on the school website under the parents page.

# About Gift Cards

\*There is a maximum of 5 cards ordered at a time except for Community Cash, Fred Meyer, Food Pavilion, Safeway and WOODS cards. (This is the arrangement negotiated with Lynden Christian, so that we do not deplete their stock.) If you need more than 5 cards, please call the SCRIP Coordinator directly so your order can be negotiated.

# About Community Cash Certificates/Lynden Dollars

Community Cash dollars come in booklets of 10 certificates (\$10 each), or \$100 certificates; or you can order a specific amount to be written as a check to a vendor (see "Specialty Checks" below). Four percent of the face value will be added to your account. Please see the current list of vendors accepting Community Cash Certificates (also known as Lynden Dollars). Note that some have restrictions on these types of purchases.

**We Appreciate our Cash Back Partners!** If you are negotiating a price with a merchant (for flooring, furniture, etc.) please inform the business up front that you intend to pay with Community Cash. Local merchants have already given up a portion of their profit by accepting Community Cash Certificates. That's why you must use the full \$10 or \$100 of each certificate; no change is given. For larger purchases, you may request a check for a specific merchant, for a specific amount. Other things to keep in mind:

- **Specialty Checks:** All specialty checks must be for more than \$100, as the Community Cash certificates and booklets can be used for purchases of \$100 and under.
- Lost Checks: Any lost specialty checks that need to have a stop payment order on them, through the Chamber's bank, will result in a charge of \$35 that will be passed along to you.
- Plan Ahead! Ordering Community Cash (especially Specialty Checks) often takes advance planning on your part. We often have booklets or certificates on hand to fill orders, but not in large numbers. Large orders may take a week to fill. Specialty checks written for specific amounts to a vendor always take a week to process, and will be ready for pickup with the next week's orders.

We will fill SCRIP orders placed during the first week of class, by noon Wednesday, Sept 2; those orders will be at the school by noon Thursday September 3. Occasionally the SCRIP program takes a break (usually on weeks with a holiday or school closure). Families will be notified as far in advance as possible if the SCRIP coordinators will be unavailable in a given week.

# Leaving the Program

Sometimes circumstances change. A "Future Eagle" family may not enroll after all, or not able to enroll due to class size or a family may move away, or decide to leave Ebenezer before the next payout. Sometimes a balance is left in the account when a student graduates. In those situations, the SCRIP money remains in the school's account. The family may decide whether to designate a family to receive their upcoming credit, OR leave it as a general donation for the Board to apply to a needy family's account.
