School policy states:

CELL PHONES/ELECTRONIC DEVICES

Students are not to use their cell phones/electronic devices during the school day, including (but not limited to) calls, texting, videos, and picture sharing. While we respect parents' wishes for student use, messages for students during the school day should go through the school's office. To avoid disrupting classes, parents are asked to call the school office if they need to contact their student. Cell phones/electronic devices that are used inappropriately will be taken by the classroom teacher and returned to the student at the end of the school day. Multiple infractions will result in the device being held in the office to be picked up by a parent.

In an emergency, students' cell phones/electronic devices may be used to assist school staff during an emergency situation.

Sub Sandwich "Wrap Up"

Saturday, February 24, was our big assembly day!

What a fantastic experience to work together with approximately 170 adult and student volunteers to make 16,030 sub sandwiches in 5 hours! God is so faithful and continues to provide for our school.

A huge THANK YOU to everyone who bought, sold, prayed, set up, assembled, and delivered the subs! With all your support, an incredible \$33,055 profit was raised all while building community and relationships amongst each other! We hope you were blessed through your service.

Fun facts:

- We assembled 16,030 subs in just 5 hours that is 1,454 more sub than last year within the 5-hour timeframe! WOW!.
- In 2020 we assembled 10,000 subs with a \$19,380 net profit.
- Four years later, with a 2-year covid break, we assembled 16,030 subs and \$33,055 net profit. That's 6,030 more subs and a \$13,675 profit increase from 2020! God continues to bless Ebenezer year after year!
- This fundraiser was started by the Granny's Club back in the 1990's making 1,000 subs in Jean Kortus' basement. It has steadily grown over the years our community loves these subs!

We continue to have faithful volunteers who have been helping for MANY, MANY years. Countless parents, grandparents, friends, staff, long time Ebenezer supporters, and even family friends willing to give of their time for the future of our school and kids.

Special thanks to Renee DeJong for her years of organizing the sub fundraiser and coming back this year to wrap subs and provide requested wisdom.
