

Teaching Them For Him

Guidance for Parents Managing Their Children's Homework

General guidelines for all parents and those helping with student homework:

- 1. Supervise, explain, assist, and direct the student while they're working. Please don't do the work for them.
- 2. Keep expectations up to classroom standards. Examples: good handwriting, complete sentences, math work shown, neatly organized, etc. Neatness counts!
- 3. Work should reflect the student's efforts, ability, and understanding.
- 4. Grade the work and direct students to correct mistakes.
- 5. Communicate with your teachers as needed with questions.

Specifics for Grades 5-8

- 1. Monitor your student's tech use. Make sure they are using the tech as it is intended.
- 2. Make sure you have good safety and security protocols in place (both software and hardware are recommended), but nothing beats having adults monitoring children while online!
- 3. Tests will be posted as scheduled by teachers, and directions for tests will be explained. Parents should monitor their students while taking tests.
- 4. Help grade math daily. This ensures that students are learning math correctly and teachers can catch mistakes and reteach as needed.
